

## 7-Device Charger FAQ's

---

- Q.** Can I use the cables that come with my phone on the PowerPro 7-Device Charger?  
**A.** Yes, you can use virtually any USB or Type-C charging cable that you have, including those that come with your device.
- Q.** Does the PowerPro 7-Device Charger have an on/off switch?  
**A.** No, there is not a Power on/off Switch.
- Q.** What does a Surge Protector do?  
**A.** A surge protector defends electronics against the harmful effects of power surges and voltage spikes. Surge protectors can absorb and dissipate the power of a surge, so that connected equipment is shielded.
- Q.** How many devices can I connect at once?  
**A.** You can plug in up to 7 devices to the PowerPro 7-Device Charger at once using the 4 USB Ports, 1 Type-C Port, and 2 AC Outlets.
- Q.** Can I leave my PowerPro 7-Device Charger plugged in all the time?  
**A.** Yes, there is no harm done if the PowerPro 7-Device Charger is left always plugged in.
- Q.** Will the PowerPro 7-Device Charger “overcharge” my cell phone or device?  
**A.** The PowerPro 7-Device Charger is designed to optimally charge your devices. This means it will charge them quickly, as well as safely.
- Q.** Can I use the PowerPro 7-Device Charger outdoors?  
**A.** The PowerPro is designed for indoor use only in dry locations.
- Q.** Can I plug an extension cord into the PowerPro 7-Device Charger?  
**A.** It is not recommended to plug additional extension cords into the PowerPro 7-Device Charger or daisy chain multiple PowerPro units together.
- Q.** Can I plug a refrigerator into the PowerPro 7-Device Charger?  
**A.** The PowerPro 7-Device Charger is not designed for large appliances such as stoves, over the range microwaves, refrigerators, AC units, etc.
- Q.** Can I use the PowerPro 7-Device Charger Internationally?  
**A.** Yes, the PowerPro 7-Device Charger is Dual Voltage and can be used internationally with the appropriate plug adapters.
- Q.** Is there a warranty?  
**A.** Yes, there is a 1-Year Limited Warranty.
