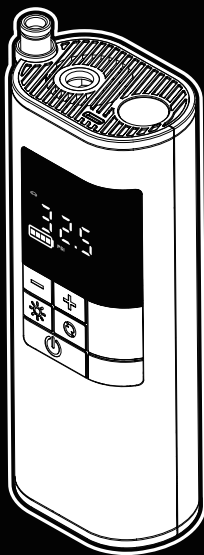

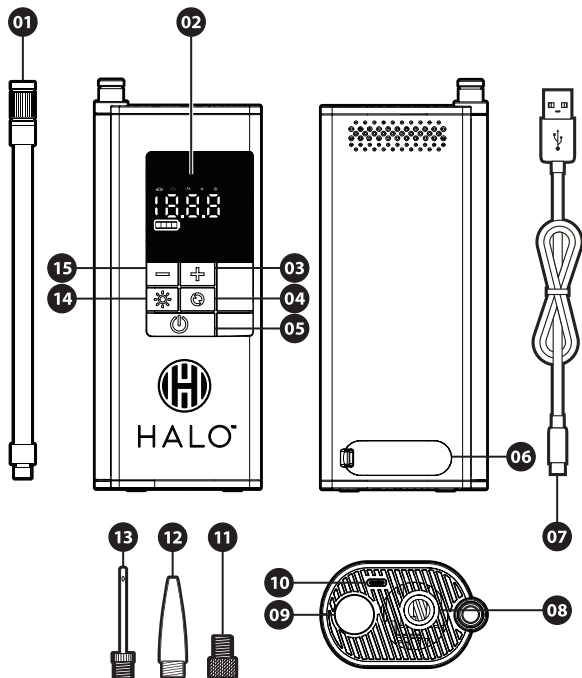

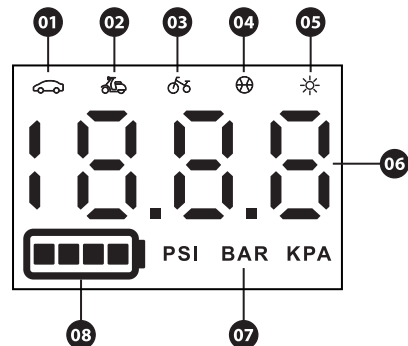

DIGITAL DISPLAY



- 01. CAR PRESET ICON:**
Car mode is active when this icon is displayed.
- 02. MOTORCYCLE PRESET ICON:**
Motorcycle mode is active when this icon is displayed.
- 03. BICYCLE PRESET ICON:**
Bicycle mode is active when this icon is displayed.
- 04. SPORTS EQUIPMENT PRESET ICON:**
Sports and leisure equipment mode is active when this icon is displayed.
- 05. FLASHLIGHT ICON:**
The flashlight function is active when this icon is displayed.
- 06. AIR PRESSURE:**
Displays the air pressure setting.
- 07. PRESSURE UNIT:**
Displays the pressure in PSI, BAR or KPA.
- 08. BATTERY LEVEL:**
Displays the charge of the internal battery.

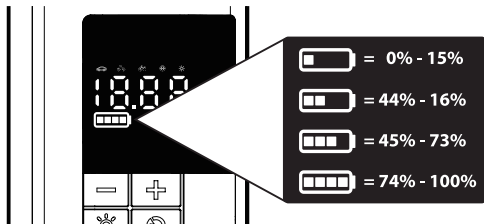
CHARGING THE AIR COMPRESSOR

IMPORTANT:

Fully charge the mini air compressor before using it for the first time. When not being used, store in a cool, dry place.

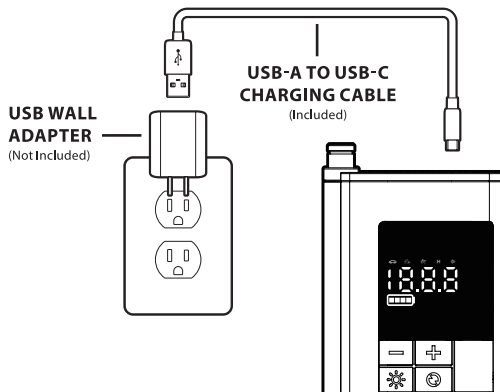
CHARGING THE MINI AIR COMPRESSOR:

- USB-C cable (included) with a wall adapter (not included) rated for 5V/3A
- LED indicator lights will display the current power level



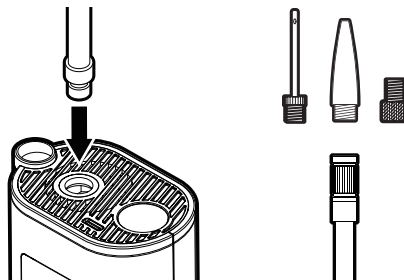
ESTIMATED CHARGING TIME:

Less than 2.0 hours via USB-C.



USING THE COMPRESSOR

1. Remove the air hose and connect it to the air compressor output. Be sure to choose the right air nozzle for the item you want to inflate and attach it to the air hose.



2. Long press the ON/OFF button to turn on the mini air compressor. Then short press the Preset Mode/Unit button to select the desired preset mode - car, motorcycle, bicycle, sports equipment.



3. Long press the preset mode/unit button to cycle through pressure units - PSI, BAR, KPA.

NOTE: PSI is the default unit of measure.

USING THE COMPRESSOR

- 3. Use the "+" and "-" pressure buttons to adjust to the desired pressure target.
- 4. To inflate, press the compressor's On/Off button. When the specified pressure target is met, the compressor will automatically turn off.



NOTE: Air compressor is not compatible with large capacity objects, such as air mattresses and inflatable swimming pools.

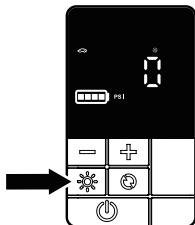

USING THE FLASHLIGHT

Long press the ON/OFF button to turn on the Mini Air Compressor. Then press the Flashlight On/Off button to turn the flashlight function on.

1. Flashlight On/Off button once = Flashlight On
2. Flashlight On/Off button twice = Emergency SOS
3. Flashlight On/Off button twice = Strobe On
4. Flashlight On/Off button twice = Flashlight off

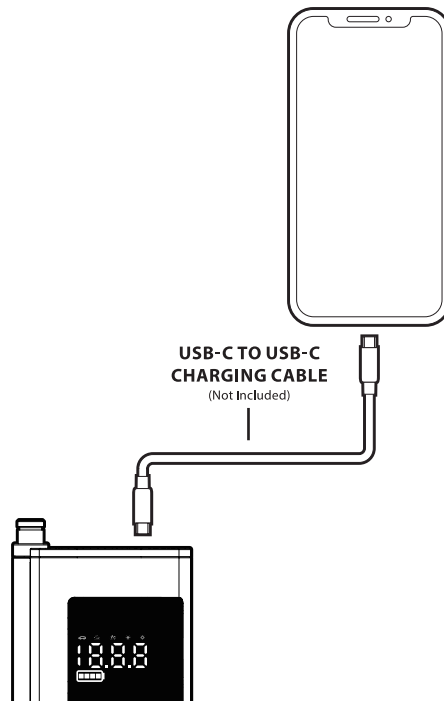

USING THE POWER BANK

The USB-C output port is rated for up to 15W.

1. Connect the appropriate cable to your device. We recommend using the USB-C charging cable provided by your device manufacturer.
2. Plug the cable into the USB-C input/output port on top of the device.
3. Charging will begin automatically.
4. When charged, disconnect cable and power off your mini air compressor.



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ISSUE	POTENTIAL CAUSE	SOLUTION
Tire or inflatable fails to inflate.	Compressor power level is insufficient.	Charge the compressor.
	Air hose is not connected correctly.	Ensure the air hose is attached correctly.
	The preset tire pressure value is lower than the current tire pressure.	Adjust the pressure value to be higher than the item's current value.
	The stem or nozzle is blocked by a foreign object.	Clear the blockage and try again.
Screen flashes L8 or H8.	Over temperature protection has been triggered.	Power down the compressor and allow unit to cool. The operating temperature range is 32° - 113°F (0° - 45°C).
