Meet Lotus

A wearable ring that controls objects at home by pointing.


The Lotus Ring functions like a remote, controlling lights, fans—anything a wall switch controls—with infrared technology. Conveniently worn on your finger, it's lightweight, waterproof, and with you at all times.




What's inside the Lotus Kit

Your Lotus Kit comes with everything you need to get started right away. Each component has been thoughtfully designed to simplify setup and use.




Ring Charging Platform




How to charge the Ring



Using the provided charging cable, connect your Ring Charging Platform to the wall plug and plug it into a wall socket.



Place the Ring onto the raised post of the Charging Platform, aligning the metal charging contacts inside the Ring with those on the post. Magnets will guide the Ring into the correct position for charging and you'll feel it snap into place.



While charging, the red light (visible inside the black band) will blink every few seconds.


Your ring is fully charged when the red light stays steady.

How to charge the Switch Covers

When you first open your Lotus kit, the switch covers may flash different color lights when pressed.

This means “low on power” (low power, so restarting) and needs to be recharged.


Even if this does not occur, **we strongly recommend that you charge your Ring and the Switch covers once for an hour before using it the first time.**



Using the provided charging cable, connect your Switch Cover to the wall plug and plug it into a wall socket.




You'll see a green light inside the Switch Cover – this simply means that the Switch Cover is successfully connected to power.



While charging, a small yellow light will blink every few seconds.

When the blinking is replaced by the yellow light staying steady, the Switch Cover is done charging.


How to use the Lotus Kit



1. Put on the Ring

Place the Ring on your index finger such that the IR band is aligned with your knuckle, and the button is on the side closest to your thumb.


A thin raised line marks the lower edge of the button, farthest from the IR band. For easier identification, we've attached a silicone bumper on the button that you can remove at any time.



2. Snap on the Switch Cover

To install the Switch Cover, align the magnets on the back with the screws on your wall switch plate. Hold it in place and let it snap on. The black window can be on the bottom or on top—the device works either way!

Press the Lotus logo on the front to engage the manual button. When the switch responds, a blue light will flash.



3. Point-and-click

Aim your Ring's black band at the Switch Cover. Then press the button once and let go - like a TV remote. No need to press down too hard or swipe.

When you click, a little red light will flash on the black strip of the Ring, confirming the button was pressed. The Switch Cover will then flash blue, confirming activation of the switch.

To control a TV, aim the ring at it and double-click.


What it controls

You can use the Ring to turn on and off anything connected to a wall switch, such as lights, fans, or appliances like a window air conditioner.


The Ring also allows you to control TVs directly, without needing the Lotus Switch Covers.

Frequently asked questions

How far away does the Ring work from?

As long as there are no major obstacles (like a wall) in the way, the Ring will activate a Switch Cover from up to 30 feet away.

Can the Ring get wet?

Yes! The Ring is water-resistant. However, it should not be submerged underwater (like in a shower or a pool).

Can I share my Ring with family and friends?

One Ring can work with infinite Switch Covers, and one Switch Cover can work with Infinite Rings. So your family and friends can use theirs in your space, and vice versa. It's like a telephone—the more people that have it, the more beneficial your own device gets!

Does the Lotus Kit need batteries?

The Lotus Ring and Switch Covers have rechargeable batteries. They only need to be charged about 3 times a year, each time for under an hour.

Where can I use my Lotus Kit?

You can use your Lotus Ring in any living space—rented or owned. You can also bring it along when traveling or visiting loved ones, or even while staying at hotels and AirB&Bs, as it is completely portable.

How do I remove a Switch Cover from a wall switch?

Simply pull it away from the wall switch until the magnets release. You will feel some resistance due to the strength of the magnets, which is normal and expected.

Are there different ring sizes?

Yes! The Lotus Ring comes in sizes 8, 10, and 12.

What if I'm between sizes?

No problem! Go for the next size up—we include free silicone adjusters in the kit to ensure the perfect fit.

Does the Ring need to be worn on a finger to work?

Not at all! While wearing the Ring is convenient, you can press the button however you like—gloved hands, held in your palm, or even with your toes—it works just the same!

Can I use my Switch Covers on a multi-gang wall switch?

Yes, your Switch Covers will work on a multi-gang panel as well.

Can I add extra Rings and Switch Covers to my home as I need them?

Absolutely! Any Ring works seamlessly with any Switch Cover. So you can add more anytime, and they'll just work—no setup needed!

How secure is it?

Totally secure! Infrared can't go through walls (just like someone can't control your TV from outside). Plus, all devices are fully offline.

What about my privacy; where does my data go?

Nowhere. Your data stays safe because these devices are completely offline.
