



Q: What is RFID protection anyway?

R F I D Stands for **R**adio **F**requency **I**dentification

RFID enabled credit cards, debit cards  and passports  have RFID chips  embedded in them that contain an individual's personal information.

Q: How do I know if my passport or credit/debit cards have RFID chips?

Passports with this symbol  have RFID chips with personal information such as Name, Date of Birth, Issue and Expiration dates.

Credit/debit cards with this symbol  have RFID chips with personal information such as Account Name and Number, plus Issue and Expiration Dates.

Q: Why is RFID protection technology important to me?

- ✓ It helps prevent identity thieves from obtaining personal information. RFID readers scan and read the information on RFID chips.
- ✓ Travelon® RFID protection wallets and pockets contain a “Faraday Shield” that helps prevent the RFID reader from reading the chip.
