INSTRUCTION MANUAL

The primary use of this unit is to project from indoors through the included sheet and onto a window so that the image is visible from outside. The projector can also be used against any flat surface indoors if you wish.

3. Screen Hanging Instructions

- Start by peeling one side of the adhesive strip (one side only) and apply the strip to the hook.
- 2. At the top of the screen, insert the two hooks into the eyelets on
- Hold the top of the screen against the window frame top, pulling the screen stretched side-to side. Be certain that the "open" side of the hook is pointing UP.
- Peel the other side of the adhesive strip and mount the hooks and screen to the top of the window frame.
- 5. Once the top of your screen is mounted, simply repeat the directions above for the bottom of the screen, pulling the screen stretched top to bottom and then side-to-side while mounting the hooks with the "open" side of the hook pointing DOWN through the eyelets on the screen.

4. ATTENTION

- 1. Please read this manual carefully before use.
- 2. To ensure stable power supply, please use an outlet with grounding.
- Please use the power supply provided with the projector. Please see qualified service personnel for repairs.
- 4. Please do not dismantle the projector.
- 5. Looking directly in to the lens may cause eye irritation.
- Do not place the projector anywhere that obstructs ventilation to the projector.
- This projector is for indoor use only. Keep away from all areas where it may get wet. Keep away from all damp areas.
- Keep the projector away from all wet and damp areas to avoid electric shock.
- Please shut off the projector and unplug the power supply when not in use
- Use the packaging provided with the projector when transporting it from place to place.

12. The USB provided is not to be used with computers. For this projector use only. Other USBs may be used with this projector, please see the types of files and formats supported in 2 above.




6. Projector Placement and Focus

To achieve the most realistic effect, place the projector on the floor or a low table facing directly onto the screen. You should attempt to fill the screen as much as possible. Move the projector backwards or forwards as needed. Once in the proper place, turn the lens to focus.

Left: Move left and volume down

10. Main Menu Operation

- 1. The unit is set to play USB first when the item is first turned on.
- To switch to another input, press the input button on the remote control or source button on the unit and choose from USB / AV / SD / VGA
- 3. You can only insert the USB or SD one at a time.

11. The unit is set to play USB when the item is first turned on. To switch to another input, either:

- Press the "Input" button on the remote control, choose from AV/SD/VGA, than press OK.
- Once these different inputs are selected, they will operate the same as the USB. Please refer to section 12 and 13 in the manual.

12. To Play Movies Using the Remote

- 1. Remove tag from the remote battery compartment.
- 2. Stand behind the unit to use the remote control.
- 3. Select "Movie" from the main menu.
- 4. Select Main Folder.
- Select either "Christmas" or "Halloween" to select multiple movies.
 Always press > I to play movies, do not press "OK".
- After the selected movie finishes playing the next movies automatically play sequentially.
- To play the same movie continuously, scroll on the movie then press "OK" on the remote. A small "X" will appear in the corner of the movie. Then press >II to play.
- 8. Press "ESC" on the remote to leave the movie that's playing, then select new movie and
 - press ►II. Do not press "OK" on the remote to select a new movie, always press ►II.

13. To Play Movies Using The Buttons On The Unit

- Scroll to "Movie" by using ▶ button and then pressing the ▼ button.
- 2. Scroll to "Folder" and then press the ▼ button.
- 3. Select movie by scrolling using the ▶ or ◀ buttons.
- 4. To play the selected movie, press the ▲ button.
- 5. Movies will automatically play sequentially.
- To play the same movie continually, scroll to the selected movie and then press ▼ . A small "x" will appear in the corner of the movie.
 Then press ▲ to play.
- Press the ▼ button when the movie is playing for other control options. Scroll using the ► or ◄ button and press ▲ to select.
 FB - Fast Backwards
 - FF Fast Forward
 - P Previous Movie
 - N Next Movie
 - S Go Back to folder to select other movies or movie category.
- Press ► or ◀ for volume while movie is playing.
- Press ▲ when the movie is playing to pause.

14. To Play Photos Using the Remote

- 1. Remove tag from the remote battery compartment.
- 2. Stand behind the unit to use the remote control.
- 3. Select "Photo" from the main menu.
- 4. Select Main Folder.
- Select any photo you want to play. Always press ►II to play photos, do not press "OK".
- After the selected photo plays for 5 seconds, the next photo will automatically play sequentially.
- To play the same photo continuously, scroll on the photo then press "OK" on the remote. A small "X" will appear in the corner of the photo. Then press >II to play.
- Press "ESC" on the remote to leave the photo that's playing, then select new photo and press ►II. Do not press "OK" on the remote to select a new photo, always press ►II.

15. To Play Photos Using The Buttons On The Unit

- Scroll to "Photo" by using ► button and then pressing the ▼ button.
- 2. Scroll to "Folder" and then press the ▼ button.
- 3. Select photo by scrolling using the ▶ or ◀ buttons.
- 4. To play the selected photo, press the ▲ button.
- Photos will automatically play. After the selected photo plays for 5 seconds, the next photo will automatically play sequentially.
- To play the same photo continually, scroll to the selected photo and then press ▼ . A small "x" will appear in the corner of the photo. Then press ▲ to play.
- Press the ▼ button when the photo is playing for other control options. Scroll using the ► or ◀ button and press ▲ to select.
 - FB Fast Backwards
 - FF Fast Forward
 - P Previous Photo
 - N Next Photo
 - S Go Back to folder to select other photo or photo category.
