CAMASSIA QUAMASH



Camassia leichtlinii is often referred to as Camassia Quamash, its native, American name. It produces linear, strap-shaped leaves and star-shaped flowers that rise above a foliage clump. Best planted in groups of 12 or more. Grows well just about anywhere - even on the edge of a water garden or pond. Best left undisturbed once located.

Profuse bloomer

*Very tolerant and forgiving
of imperfect conditions*

Can be used in a rain garden

About This Variety: Camassia Quamash produces blooms of blue with yellow anthers.

Growing Instructions: To ensure optimal results: allow adequate space, sunlight, plant at the appropriate depth, feed with a well balanced fertilizer and allow the leaves to die back before removing. For an informal look, plant in groups in natural swathes.

Care Tip: Plant in well draining soil. After planting, water well to settle the bulbs.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 12-14" tall

Spacing: Plant 2" apart, 4" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-9
