DUTCH IRIS MIXED



Often grown as annuals, Dutch iris hybrids grow from bulbs that are able to be planted in fall or spring. These graceful and elegant flowers are a favorite and bloom atop grass-like foliage. They are easy to grow and, if the zone is appropriate, are excellent for naturalizing. Using Dutch Irises as cut flowers is a popular choice.

*Plant in full sun to full shade*

*Great florist quality cut flower*

*Deer and critter resistant*

*About This Variety:* Mixture consists of a wide range of varieties, colors and patterns for producing a natural look. Buy several packs to increase your color range and to create an optimum curb appeal effect.

*Growing Instructions:* Choose a site that has reasonably fertile soil and plenty of moisture that won't dry out in summer. Good drainage and a sheltered location will help them survive the winter.

*Care Tip:* Plant about 15 bulbs per square foot. Zone 5 gardeners should add a 2" layer of mulch in fall. Best planted in large numbers.

*Exposure:* Full sun to partial shade

*Height:* Grows 18-20"

*Spacing:* Plant 4" apart, 5" deep

*USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 6-8
