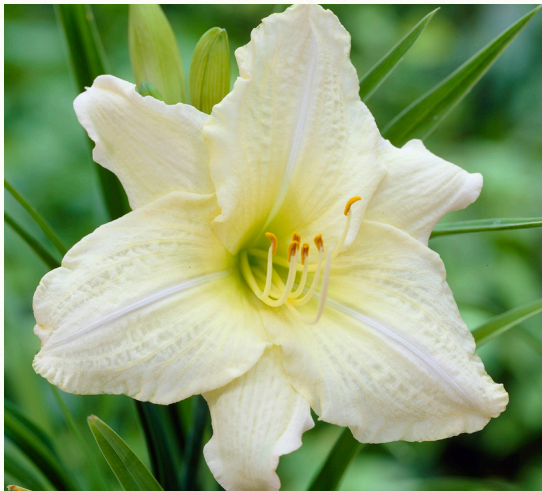


Van Zyverden's
DAYLILY JOAN SENIOR



The daylily (*hemerocallis*) is considered a 'sure bet' perennial. They thrive throughout most of the country with the exception of the very deep south. They tolerate less than ideal conditions and will bloom faithfully for years with virtually no attention. As the name implies, daylily flowers open in the morning and die by nightfall. Each flower stem typically has at least a dozen flower buds and the plant stays in bloom for many weeks. They should be planted in every garden.

Rebloomer

Very easy to grow

Long bloom period

About This Variety: Hemerocallis Joan Senior is known and appreciated for its huge 6" diameter flowers that are white with a light green throat. Its flowers are abundant, borne above grassy like green foliage. It is a rebloomer and most popular among the white daylilies.

Growing Instructions: Best planted in groups for dramatic effect in full sun, in moist, yet well drained soil. Excellent ground cover, as a single specimen or in mass plantings to create a focal point in the garden.

Care Tip: They are tough, robust plants, so not much can go wrong.

Blooms: Early and Late Summer

Exposure: Full Sun

Height: Grows 20-26" tall

Spacing: Plant 18-24" apart, 0.5' deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 4-11
