Daffodil classifications become quite technical, as they are divided into 13 divisions according to their flower shape and heritage by the American Daffodil Society. They do well throughout most of the U.S., as long as there is a discernible winter. Daffodils are ideal for large plantings and naturalizing, making them an exceptional value item and providing years of carefree color.

Growing Instructions: In fall, plant the bulbs pointy end up, in deep, fertile, well draining soil in full sun to light shade. Bulbs do not like wet feet. Water during their growth period. Fertilization helps growth and natural increase by offsets. Daffodils can be left undisturbed to naturalize for years. If you cannot plant them immediately, store in a cool, airy place.

Care Tip: When given ample sun light, water, and proper nutrition, removing the flowers as soon as they fade and allowing the leaves to brown before removing, they will return for years to come with little other effort.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 14-16"

Spacing: Plant 8" apart, 6" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 3-8
