THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	A balanced mix of 24 bulbs - Non-scented Tulip 'Angelique' (12/+cm bulbs) with double, two-tone pink and white flowers Scented Tulip 'Blue Diamond' (12/+cm bulbs) with double, violet blue flowers Scented Tulip 'Mount Tacoma' (12/+cm bulbs) with double, white flowers Or: A balanced mix of 24 bulbs - Non-scented Tulip 'Abba' (12/+cm bulbs) with double, red flowers Scented Tulip 'Orange Princess' (12/+cm bulbs) with double, orange flowers Bon-scented Tulip 'Wedding Gift' (12/+cm bulbs) with double, pink flowers
ON ARRIVAL	 • Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. • Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. • If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<u>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</u> • Use a trowel to dig holes 6-8" deep. • Set a bulb in the centre of each, making sure the pointy end is facing upwards, and cover with crumbled soil. • Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. • Space individual bulbs 6" apart. <u>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</u> • Pot bulbs into containers filled with good quality compost. • Half fill a pot with compost and plant bulbs at about three times the depth of the bulb's height. • Space bulbs about 2" apart. • Top up with compost • Water well.
WATERING	Water immediately after planting.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	• Once they have finished flowering, nip off flower heads to keep them tidy. • As soon as the foliage has died back, lift, dry and store bulbs in a cool, dry place until replanting in autumn.
FEEDING	Once shoots emerge above ground in spring, feed weekly with a liquid fertiliser that's high in potash. Stop feeding when leaves start to die back in early summer.
