

Marigold Ombre Metal Lantern with Butterfly Shadow Cast

To ensure the maximum performance of your lantern, please read and save these instructions.


This product is fixed with rotating LED light. To avoid fire hazard, do not disassemble the rotating LED light for real candle use.

Rotating LED Light Modes

ON1-OFF-ON2

ON1 position: Color Morphing light with 4-hour timer = 4 hours on, 20 hours off. Cycle automatically repeats daily.

ON2 position: Warm White light with 4-hour timer = 4 hours on, 20 hours off. Cycle automatically repeats daily.



FOR INITIAL USE AND BATTERY PLACEMENT (Batteries are not included):

- Remove the battery compartment from the lantern.
- Unscrew the weather-resistant lid.
- Place three (3) AA batteries only into battery compartment.
- Screw the weather-resistant lid back on and put the battery compartment back into the lantern.

USE AND CARE:

- Do not place near any heat source.
- Place on a protective base to avoid wax or oil deposits.
- Requires three (3) AA batteries, not included.
- Install only new batteries of the same type in your product. For best results, use Alkaline batteries.
- Failure to insert batteries in the correct polarity, as indicated in the battery compartment, may shorten the life of the batteries or cause batteries to leak.
- Turn off when not in use to save battery life.
- Dispose of old batteries immediately.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per state and local guidelines.
- Batteries may explode or leak.
- Do not mix Alkaline, standard (Carbon-Zinc) or Rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) or (Nickel Metal Hydride) batteries.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire.

DO NOT attempt to recharge, use different sizes of batteries or install batteries backward. Never touch damaged or leaking batteries this could result in burn injuries or cause serious internal injuries if swallowed. Obtain medical attention immediately if this occurs. Misuse may cause battery to overheat, rupture, leak or explode, resulting in personal injury and or property damage.

DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING:

Waste electrical products should not be disposed of with household waste. Please recycle where facilities exist. Check with your local authority or retailer for recycling advice. This applies to the battery also.
