PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.) Please unpack immediately & remove the plants from the packaging. Water your plants right away with room-temperature water. Store your new plants upright indoors, in a bright, part-shady location for up to 72 hours until ready to plant.
- 2.) Choose a location. Be sure it matches the needs of your new plants.
- 3.) Prepare your space; remove any nearby weeds and/or grass. Mix in compost or a slow-release fertilizer periodically after planting throughout the season.
- 4.) Think about your timing - wait to plant until after the last freeze in your region.
- 5.) Time to Plant! Start by digging a hole that is slightly deeper & wider than the root ball. If your plants are in plastic pots, gently remove the pot by holding the plant on its side and lightly massaging the pot. Position your plants so they are at the same soil level as in the pot. Fill holes with loose soil and compact lightly. After planting, water your plants thoroughly.
