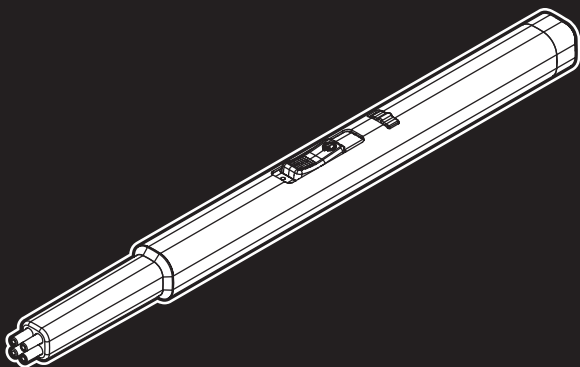

Please read instructions carefully and utilize the proper precautions before operating this equipment. Save instructions for future reference.

- When used correctly, lithium-ion rechargeable batteries provide a safe and dependable source of portable power. However, if they are misused or abused, this may result in leakage, burns, fire, or explosion, causing personal injury or damage to other devices.
- Misusing or incorrectly connecting your Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ may cause electric shock to users and damage equipment.
- Keep your Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ dry and away from moisture, water, and corrosive materials.
- Do not expose your Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ to moisture, water, rain, or snow.
- Keep your Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ away from heat sources, including open flames, radiators, stoves, ovens, and any other devices that produce heat.
- Do not expose to fire or excessive temperature. Do not expose to heat above 212°F (100°C) or incinerate.
- In the unlikely event of leakage or explosion use sand or a chemical fire extinguisher.
- Do not disassemble your Rechargeable Lighter Wand+. There are no user-serviceable parts inside. Incorrect reassembly may result in shock or fire hazard.
- Do not drop or subject to strong impacts. Do not operate your plasma lighter wand if it has received a sharp blow, or has otherwise been damaged in any way.
- Do not puncture, crush, or subject to mechanical shock.
- Keep away from children and pets. The Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ is not a toy.
- Make sure the Rechargeable Lighter Wand+'s charging ports do not become contaminated with lint or other debris. Use a canned-air type of product periodically to ensure that the port openings are clear.
- Do not touch the plasma prongs while igniting the lighter.

PRODUCT MAINTENANCE



IF THE RECHARGEABLE LIGHTER WAND+ OVERHEATS, BECOMES SWOLLEN, OR IS DEFORMED IN ANY WAY, IMMEDIATELY STOP USING THE PRODUCT AND CONTACT CUSTOMER SERVICE.

EQUIPMENT CLEANING:

- Please make sure that the device is disconnected from all input power and output devices.
- Wipe with a clean, dry cloth.
- Do not use corrosive cleaners or solvents.
- Do not insert metal objects into the ports to clean them as this could cause electrical shock. Blow any debris out with a canned-air type of product.

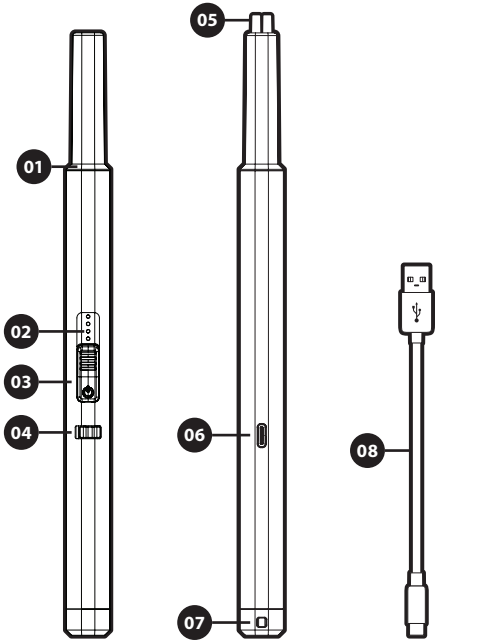

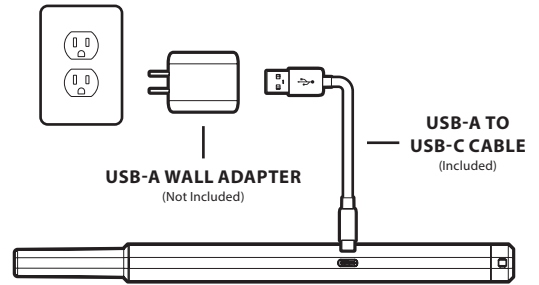
PRODUCT OVERVIEW

CHARGE YOUR RECHARGEABLE LIGHTER WAND+



- 1 LED Light Ring
- 2 LED Battery Level Indicator
- 3 ON/OFF Power Slider
- 4 Lock Switch
- 5 Dual Arc Plasma Prongs
- 6 USB-C Charging Port
- 7 Lanyard Hole
- 8 USB-A to USB-C Cable

Fully charge the Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ before use. To charge, connect the Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ to the included USB-C cable. The unit can be recharged from any USB powered port, like a wall adapter, car adapter, laptop and more. The Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ should be fully charged in approximately one hour (5-100%).



LED BLUE INDICATOR

The blue LED indicator is located near the Power Slider. When product is in use, indicators will light to indicate battery level. When charging, the indicator will flash to indicate the current charge level. When fully charged, all four indicators will be on solid.

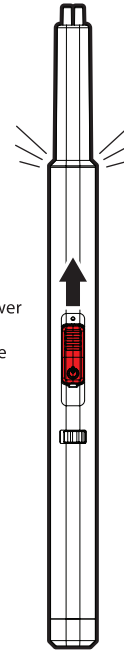
NOTE: The Rechargeable Lighter Wand+ arc will shut off after 10s of continuous ignition.

power slider.

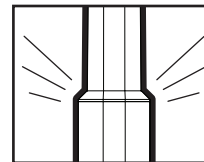
