

Alli's Styling Tips



The Perfect Blowout Collection

1. Start with super-clean hair! Dirty, oily hair doesn't blow-out well.
2. Always work in clean, small, 1-2 inch sections. Start in the front at your hairline and perfect each section before moving onto the next. Try to avoid putting dry hair on top of wet hair.
3. Using **Buttercup Blow Dryer** and your **Half Pint Brush**, get as close to your roots as possible. Roll Half Pint Brush all the way to the ends, drying in a repetitive motion until the section you're working on is completely dry.
4. Once your hair is completely dry, and still warm from the blowout, separate a 1-2 inch section in the front of your crown. Pull the section forward, comb and roll in a **High Top Roller** from ends to roots, rolling away from your face. Repeat through the back of your crown and anywhere you need to help add extra volume!
5. Spray **The Sheriff Hairspray** to help lock in lift for lasting volume.
6. Allow to cool 10-15 minutes. (Good time to do your makeup!) Rock and unroll!



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
