THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	Amazing Agapanthus Choice of EITHER Blue or White x 3
ON ARRIVAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dig a shallow hole. Place the root in the centre of the hole, spread the roots out and plant so shoot tips are covered with 2" of soil. Cover the root with crumbled soil and gently firm into position. Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pot roots directly into containers filled with well-drained compost in a 8" wide pot. Fill about two thirds of the pot with compost and place the bare root plant inside. Spread out the root and cover with compost. Aim to cover the shoot tips with 2" of soil. Cover, firm into place and water well.
WATERING	These plants will grow best if watered regularly during the growing season, especially during hot, dry spells.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Plants will produce flowers for longer if stems carrying fading blooms are removed. However, some people like to leave the blooms in place to form attractive autumn seed heads.
FEEDING	Once established, encourage flowering by feeding plants every fortnight with a balanced liquid feed during the growing season until flowers begin to show colour.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	If plants are in the ground, protect roots from frost by surrounding clumps with a 2" deep layer of garden compost, leafmould or composted bark – remove the material in late winter. Move plants in pots to a frost-free place. Alternatively, stand them on pot feet to improve drainage and cover with horticultural fleece during a cold snap.
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	One plant per 8" wide pot. As the plant matures, it will need moving into a slightly larger pot in spring. Do this on an annual basis.
