PRODUCT INFO	M13599: de Jager 7 – Piece Large flowering Double Begonias
THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	7 Double Begonias. Complete range of 7 different colours
ON ARRIVAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Open packaging immediately upon arrival.</li> <li>• Ideally, plant your bare root astilbes as soon as possible.</li> <li>• Avoid planting if the ground is frozen or waterlogged.</li> <li>• If planting is delayed, store the bulbs in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.</li> </ul>
WHERE TO PLANT	<p><u>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dig a shallow hole that's wide enough to accommodate the root.</li> <li>• Place the plant in the centre of the hole, spread the roots out and plant so the root is about 1" beneath the surface with shoots facing upwards.</li> <li>• Cover the root with crumbled soil and gently firm into position.</li> <li>• Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler.</li> <li>• Space individual plants 12" apart.</li> </ul> <p><u>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pot roots directly into containers filled with good quality compost. One is perfect in a 8" wide pot.</li> <li>• Fill about two thirds of the pot with compost and place the bulb inside.</li> <li>• The root should be cover with about 1" of compost, with shoots facing upwards.</li> <li>• Cover, firm into place and water well.</li> </ul>
WATERING	These plants need watering regularly during the growing season, especially during hot, dry spells.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Cut flower stalks back to the base once the blooms fade.
FEEDING	No feeding required.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	The foliage of these plants will start to die back in autumn. Cut to the ground. No further care is needed.
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	One plant per 8" wide pot.
