THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	1 x non-scented Eucomis bicolor (8" bulbs) with spikes of pale green, purple edged flowers.
ON ARRIVAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. • Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. • If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plant bulbs in 6" deep holes. • Set a bulb in the centre of each and cover with crumbled soil. • Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. • Space individual bulbs 12" apart. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pot bulbs into containers filled with well-drained compost, such as John Innes No.2. One is perfect in a 6" wide pot. • Fill the pot with compost and dig a 6" deep hole. • Pop the bulb in the hole. • Cover, firm the surface and water well.
WATERING	These plants will grow best if watered regularly during the growing season, especially during hot, dry spells.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Cut the foliage and old flower stems to the ground when they start to die back in autumn.
FEEDING	No feeding required.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	Keep bulbs in the ground snug with a 2" deep mulch of composted bark or garden compost – if you have an exposed garden, lift bulbs and place in a tray of dry compost. Store in a frost-free place. Move plants in pots to a frost-free place, such as a greenhouse, cold frame or front porch.
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	One bulb per 7" wide pot (they are best in long, tapering style pots). Three bulbs per 12" wide pot.
