THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	24 of a balance mix of vibrant colours
ON ARRIVAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a trowel to dig 4" deep holes. Spread a little grit in the bottom of each to improve drainage. Set a bulb in the centre of each and cover with crumbled soil. Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. Space individual bulbs 4" apart. Plant bulbs in groups for maximum impact. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pot bulbs into containers filled with well-drained compost, such as John Innes No.2. Seven bulbs are perfect in a 16" wide pot. Fill the pot with compost, leaving a 2" gap at the top for watering. Plant bulbs in 4" deep holes, spacing them out evenly. Cover, firm the surface and water well.
WATERING	These plants will grow best if watered regularly during the growing season, especially during hot, dry spells.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	After their flowers fade, cut stalks off at the base.
FEEDING	Once flower spikes appear, feed plants every two weeks with a fertiliser that's high in potash.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	If you live in a mild part of the country, keep bulbs in the ground snug over winter by covering with a 2" deep layer of garden compost or composted bark. Those with more exposed gardens should lift bulbs from the ground when the leaves turn brown – snap off the foliage, dry bulbs and store them in a frost-free place until spring. Move bulbs in pots to a frost-free place.
