THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	M138610 de Jager 3-Piece Scented Double Peonies
ON ARRIVAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bare roots. Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a trowel to dig holes 6" deep. Set a bulb in the centre of each, making sure the pointy end is facing upwards, and cover with crumbled soil. Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. Space individual bulbs 6" apart. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pot bulbs into containers filled with good quality compost. Half fill a pot with compost and plant bare roots at about three times the depth of the bare roots height just below the surface. Space bulbs about 3" apart. Top up with compost Water well.
WATERING	Water immediately after planting.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Once they have finished flowering, nip off flower heads to keep them tidy. As soon as the foliage has died back, lift, dry and store bulbs in a cool, dry place until replanting in autumn.
FEEDING	Once shoots emerge above ground in spring, feed weekly with a liquid fertiliser that's high in potash. Stop feeding when leaves start to die back in early summer.
