| THIS SELECTION CONTAINS | M138611 - 5 x Zantedeschia Mixed Colours |
| ON ARRIVAL | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. Avoid planting if the ground is frozen or waterlogged. If planting is delayed, store the root in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready. |
| WHERE TO PLANT | <p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dig planting holes 16" apart, which are the same depth as the rootball of the plant and twice its width. Place the plant in the centre of the hole, add soil around the sides of the rootball and gently firm into position. Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pot young plants into 12" wide containers filled with good quality compost. Spread some compost in the bottom of the container, and stand the young plant in the centre. There should be a 2" gap between the top of the rootball and the lip of the container. Fill the gap around the rootball with compost, firming down as you work towards the top. Water well and stand the pot in a sunny spot. |
| WATERING | These plants will grow best if watered regularly during the growing season, especially during hot, dry spells. |
| PRUNING / TRIMMING | After their flowers fade, cut stalks off at the base. |
| FEEDING | Once flower spikes appear, feed plants every two weeks with a fertiliser that's high in potash. |
| WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS | Lift bulbs from the ground prior to the first frosts of autumn – cut off the foliage, clean away soil and allow bulbs to dry. Stand them in trays of dry compost and store in a cool, dark and frost-free place (a shed or garage is perfect) until spring. Move bulbs in pots to a frost-free place. |
| CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER | Start bulbs off in 6" wide pots and promote to 12" wide pots in late May or early June, after the final frost in your area. |
