ON ARRIVAL 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. • Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. • If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a trowel to dig holes three times the length of the bulbs. • Sprinkle some horticultural grit in the base to improve drainage. • Set a bulb in the centre of each and cover with crumbled soil. • Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. • Space individual bulbs 12" apart. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pot bulbs into containers filled with good quality compost. • Fill the pot with compost and dig holes three times the length of the bulbs. • Pop a bulb in each hole. • Cover, firm the surface and water well.
WATERING	These plants will grow best if watered regularly during the growing season, especially during hot, dry spells.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	Stalks are at risk of snapping in windswept areas, so support individual stems with canes. Remove fading flowers to keep plants tidy and to prevent seed heads from forming.
FEEDING	Once established, feed plants every two weeks over summer. Use a high potash fertiliser, following the instructions on the packaging.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	Cut the main stem to ground level when it turns brown in autumn and then cover the soil with a 5cm mulch of garden compost or composted bark to insulate from frost. Move plants in pots into a greenhouse, shed or front porch.
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	Three bulbs per 12" wide pot. Six bulbs per 18" wide pot.
