PLANT CARE INSTRUCTIONS	
THIS COLLECTION CONTAIN	SKU - M138622 - de Jager Mini Multiflowering Tulips x 36
ON ARRIVAL 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulbs. • Ideally, plant your bulbs as soon as possible. • If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p>PLANTING IN-GROUND (BED OR BORDER)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a trowel to dig holes 6-8" deep. • Set a bulb in the centre of each, making sure the pointy end is facing upwards, and cover with crumbled soil. • Water well with a watering can fitted with a sprinkler. • Space individual bulbs 6" apart. <p>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pot bulbs into containers filled with good quality compost. • Half fill a pot with compost and plant bulbs at about three times the depth of the bulb's height. • Space bulbs about 5cm apart. • Top up with compost • Water well.
WATERING	Water immediately after planting.
PRUNING / TRIMMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Once they have finished flowering, nip off flower heads to keep them tidy. • As soon as the foliage has died back, lift, dry and store bulbs in a cool, dry place until replanting in autumn.
FEEDING	Once shoots emerge above ground in spring, feed weekly with a liquid fertiliser that's high in potash. Stop feeding when leaves start to die back in early summer.
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	No special care required
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	Six bulbs per 12" wide container. Space about 2" apart
