PRODUCT INFO	M138723 - de Jager 1-Piece Gigantic Appleblossom Amaryllis
THIS SELECTION CONTAINS	1 x non-scented Amaryllis 'Apple Blossom' (15" bulbs) with pink blushed, white flowers
ON ARRIVAL	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Open packaging immediately upon arrival to allow air to circulate around the bulb. • Ideally, plant your bulb as soon as possible. • If planting is delayed, store in a dark, cool and frost-free place until you are ready.
WHERE TO PLANT	<p><u>PLANTING IN CONTAINERS OR BASKETS INDOORS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pick a pot that's wide enough for the large bulb to fit comfortably, with plenty of room underneath for its fleshy roots. • Mix some multipurpose compost with a handful of perlite and spread a thin layer of the material across the bottom of the pot. • Lower the bulb into the pot. When all the roots are inside, add more compost. Don't bury the bulb – its neck and shoulders should remain above the surface. • Water the compost and place the pot on a cool, south-facing windowsill. • Over the next few weeks a flower stalk will appear. As it develops it will grow towards the light - turn the pot around every day to ensure the stalk remains upright, rather than at an angle.
WATERING	Water plants occasionally while in growth to prevent compost drying out, but don't overwater as this can lead to the bulb rotting
PRUNING / TRIMMING	When flowers start to fade allow the stalk to die back naturally before pulling it away from the bulb.
FEEDING	Once flower buds appear, feed weekly with a weak solution of liquid tomato fertiliser high in potash
WINTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS	After all the flowers have died, the foliage will continue to grow so keep plants well-watered and feed weekly with a general-purpose plant food. In early autumn the leaves will start to turn yellow. Allow the compost to completely dry out and let the foliage die back as the hippeastrum enters its dormant phase. When flower shoots appear in a few months time, you can start the growing process all over again.
CONTAINER SIZE + RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF PLANTS PER CONTAINER	1 bulb per 6" wide pot, or slightly wider if necessary. The bulb should fit fairly snugly inside.
